CA AB 1407	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Lieu (D) Airports: Air Carriers Requires certain airports to provide specified services to passengers and prospective customers, including notice of delayed flights.

CA AB 1943	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Leno (D) Commercial Airlines: Passenger Rights Requires, whenever passengers have boarded an aircraft and departure of the aircraft from the airport is delayed longer than a certain number of hours or a certain number of hours have passed following landing of the aircraft and passengers have not disembarked from the aircraft, that the air carrier provide passengers with electrical service, fresh air and light, waste removal service and adequate food and drinking water and other refreshments. Authorizes the bringing of an action for violation.

CA AB 2142	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Swanson (D) Vehicle Rental Agreements: Customer Facility Charge Permits the Oakland International Airport to require the collection of a customer facility charge for a period of up to 10 years from the imposition of the charge if a bond or other form of indebtedness is not used for financing.

CA AB 2834	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Maze (R) Commercial Space Flight Sets for findings and declarations relating to commercial human space flight in this state and related definitions as related to laws governing contracts for the conveyance of property, persons, or messages from one place to another.

CA SB 911	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Wiggins (D) Commercial Air Carriers: Hot Air Balloons. Extends the applicable dates of existing laws related to business licenses, liability insurance, and other regulations regarding a person who furnishes or provides transportation by hot air balloon for entertainment or recreational purposes.

CA SB 1118	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Negrete McLeod (D) Airports: Airport Land Use Commissions Eliminates the authority of a county board of supervisors to adopt a resolution exempting a county from establishing an airport land use commission. Limits the authority of a board and a city selection committee of mayors to designate a body to assume the responsibilities of such a commission. Repeals the authority of Marin County to overrule an airport land use commission's action. Repeals a prohibition upon an airport commission charging fees if it has not adopted an airport land use compatibility plan.

CA SB 1462	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Maldonado (R) Navigable Waters: Seaplanes Requires the Department of Transportation to establish requirements for the landing, docking, and takeoff of a seaplane on the navigable waterways of the state.

CA SB 1510	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Kehoe (D) San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Makes changes to how the governing board of the San Diego Regional Airport Authority is selected. Prohibits a board member from receiving certain benefits but allows a board member to elect to participate in a plan of health and welfare benefits for which they pay. Authorizes the authority to act as police department with respect to disposition of unclaimed property in its possession. Authorizes a company that rents cars to collect a customer facility charge if collection is required by the authority.

CA SB 1577	AUTHOR: TITLE: SUMMARY:	Florez (D) Airports: Security Checkpoint Donation Programs Requires an airport, upon the request of a qualified organization, to post notices of items that are not permitted on aircraft and that are subject to confiscation by the Transportation Security Administration. Provides an area prior to the TSA security checkpoint where air carrier passengers may deposit for donation, unopened toiletry items. Requires a participating qualified organization to pick up donated items on a periodic and regular basis.

CA SB 1736	AUTHOR:	Romero (D)

TITLE: California Community Colleges: Consortium on Aerospace

SUMMARY:

Authorize the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges to establish a Consortium on Aerospace Manufacturing to develop and promote specialized vocational curriculum geared to fulfilling the need for skilled workers in the aerospace industry.
