

## What is a Concept of Operations (ConOps)?

---

- ◆ First document in a systems engineering process



- ◆ Describes a system from the viewpoint of an individual or organization who will be using the system
- ◆ Intended for a broad audience but relatively detailed
- ◆ Codifies decisions made by the TAC thus far into a single technical document



## How the ConOps Will be Used

---

- ◆ Easy to read introduction to the system for anyone looking to learn about the program from a technical perspective
- ◆ Basis for developing a requirements document
- ◆ Basis for the procurement of vendors
