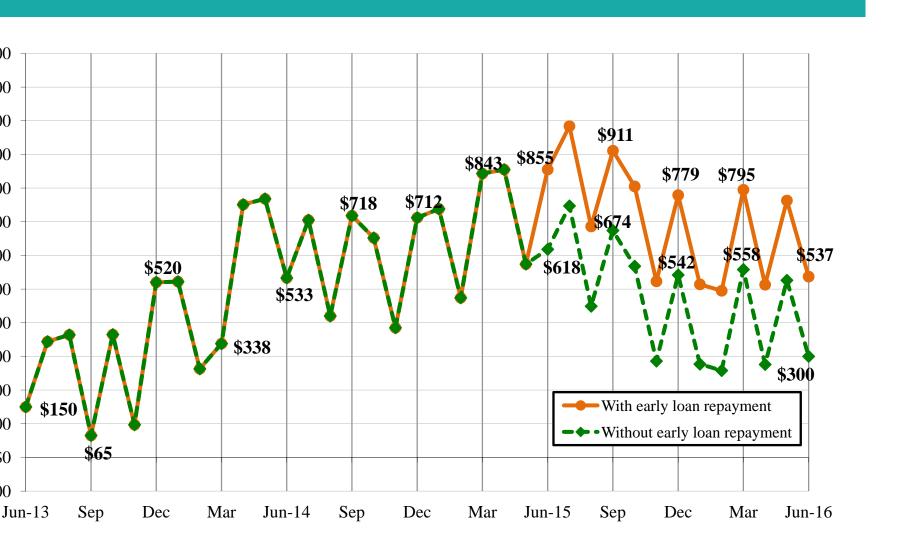
uthorized changes include project increases and decreases pursuant to the Commission's G-12 process and project rescissions.

- Total allocations are \$1.4 billion towards 269 projects through January, including authorized changes.
- Total remaining capacity is \$2.2 billion.
- TCRP is over allocated by \$7 million.

xcise Taxes on Gasoline Update

- The California State Board of Equalization approved a decrease in excise taxes on gasoline by 3.5 cents per gallon.
 - Starting July 1st, 2014 combined excise taxes on gasoline will be \$0.36 cents per gallon.
 - A decrease of approximately \$500 million.
- The Department has accounted for the decrease in revenues in the 2014 STIP FE.
 - No impact to program capacity.

- Insolvency projected as early as August 2014.

President's Proposed 2015 Budget

- Mainly follows MAP-21 programmatic structures.
