Subject: FINANCIAL ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY ADMINISTERED STIP PROJECTS ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION FP-13-55

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission allocate \$625,000 for the locally administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) City of Woodlake Downtown Enhancement Project Phase 4 (PPNO 6658) project in Tulare County, on the State Highway System.

ISSUE:

The attached vote list describes one locally administered STIP project on the State Highway System totaling \$625,000, plus \$101,000 from other sources. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project and is requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$625,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2012, Budget Act Items 2660-301-0042 and 2660-301-0890 for one locally administered STIP project described on the attached vote list.
