**Subject:** STIP AMENDMENT 14S-05

## **SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Transportation will request that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the requested State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment at the next scheduled Commission meeting following the notice period.

## **ISSUE:**

The Cities of San Jose/Palo Alto and Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) propose to amend the 2014 STIP to delete \$1,350,000 Regional Improvement Program (RIP) construction funds in Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 from the Alameda Grand Boulevard - Phase 2 project (PPNO 0416Q) and reprogram these funds to FY 2016-17 construction for the US-101/Adobe Creek Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge project (PPNO 2015D) in Santa Clara County.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Alameda Grand Boulevard - Phase 2 project is currently programmed for construction with \$1,350,000 RIP in FY 2016-17. The City of San Jose is the implementing agency. Since the project is ready for delivery now, it is proposed to swap \$1,350,000 RIP funds with an equal amount of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality funds and local funds which are currently programmed to the US-101/Adobe Creek Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge project (PPNO 2015D). That project is currently programmed with \$3,000,000 RIP for construction in FY 2016-17. The City of Palo Alto is the implementing agency for that project.

The Metropolitan Transportation Commission concurs with the changes described above and tabulated on the following pages.
