**Subject:** MONTHLY REPORT ON PROJECTS AMENDED INTO THE SHOPP BY DEPARTMENT ACTION

**SUMMARY:**

Since the October 2014 report to the California Transportation Commission (Commission), the California Department of Transportation (Department) amended 28 new capital projects into the 2014 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP), as summarized in Attachment 1. The amendments noted below will be funded from the Major Damage Restoration, Safety Improvement, Mandates, Bridge Preservation, Roadway Preservation Reservations and 2014 SHOPP programming capacity.
