Subject: **RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS OF NECESSITY**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt Resolutions of Necessity (Resolution) CR-154 through CR-162, rescinding Resolutions C-21441, C-21410, C-21412, C-21413, C-21415, C-21416, C-21389, C-21390, and C-21444. In accordance with statutory requirements, the owners have been advised that the Department is requesting rescission of Resolutions C-21441, C-21410, C-21412, C-21413, C-21415, C-21416, C-21389, C-21390, and C-21444, as summarized on the following pages.

ISSUE:

On December 9, 2015, January 20, 2016, and March 16, 2016 the Commission adopted Resolutions C-21441, C-21410, C-21412, C-21413, C-21415, C-21416, C-21389, C-21390, and C-21444. These Resolutions are now being rescinded because funding for the project has been withdrawn.

BACKGROUND:

Resolutions C-21441, C-21410, C-21412, C-21413, C-21415, C-21416, C-21389, C-21390, and C-21444 were adopted on December 9, 2015, January 20, 2016, and March 16, 2016 for Segment 13 of the State Route (SR) 138 widening project in Los Angeles County. These Resolutions authorized condemnation of land in fee for a State highway and underlying fee. Subsequent to the adoption of these Resolutions, funding for the project has been withdrawn. As such, the Department is cancelling all activities associated with the project, including condemnation. Based on the above, it is requested that these Resolutions be rescinded at the August 17-18, 2016 Commission meeting.







Part "A"

All that land lying Northerly of the following described line:

A strip of land 40.00 feet wide, the Northeasterly line being coincident with the Southwesterly line of Antelope Highway, being 150.00 feet wide as described in Book 13604, page 102, in the Office of the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of said county.
