Dear Senator Beall, Assembly Member Frazier, Senator Wieckowski, and Assembly Member Bloom:

In compliance with Streets and Highway Code Section 164.6, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has, on each odd-numbered year, provided the Legislature a Five-Year Maintenance Plan and a separate Ten-Year State Highway Operations and Protection Program Plan.

This year, in an effort to conform with recent asset-management requirements at the state and federal level, Caltrans has developed a single integrated State Highway System Management Plan that fulfills the objectives of both of the above-mentioned plans along with an investment plan. This unified plan affords a more holistic assessment of the State highway system's maintenance and rehabilitation needs as well as a data-driven strategy to address those needs.

Caltrans previously prepared a draft Plan prior to enactment of the new transportation funding package in SB 1 (Beall). However, Caltrans did not submit that draft Plan to the Legislature so it could be updated to reflect the funding components of SB 1 to provide up-to-date information on the state's transportation needs and investment plan. This Plan will be consistent with performance objectives in SB 1 and the California Transportation Commission adopted

performance targets for pavements, bridges, culverts and Transportation Management System elements. Once this updated Plan is completed, the Legislature will receive a copy and can comment. Caltrans anticipates that this draft will be available by the end of June 2017.
