BACKGROUND:

The Active Transportation Program (ATP) is a program of projects adopted by the Commission for allocation of transportation funds for projects with the overall goal to encourage increased use of active modes of transportation. The ATP funds are distributed through three competitively awarded components: Statewide component (50%), Small Urban and Rural component (10%), and the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) component (40%). The 2017 ATP must be adopted by April 1, 2017.
