Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, 2017), also known as "The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017," provides additional revenues for transportation system improvements through increased fuel taxes and vehicle registration fees. New revenues generated by SB 1 will be deposited into the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account and a percentage of these monies will be provided monthly by formula to cities and counties to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on the local streets and roads system.

SB 1 emphasizes the importance of accountability and transparency in delivering transportation system improvements. Therefore, in order to be eligible to receive Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funding for local streets and roads, cities and counties are required to provide basic Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account project reporting to the California Transportation Commission (Commission). The Local Streets and Roads Funding Reporting Guidelines will describe the general policies and procedures for carrying out the annual Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account project reporting requirements and other statutory objectives of the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.

The Guidelines are being developed in consultation with state, regional, and local government representatives and other transportation stakeholders. Draft Guidelines were released for public comment on June 30<sup>th</sup> and are available online [here](#).
