Subject: ANNUAL FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 LUMP SUM SHOPP MINOR CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM ALLOCATION RESOLUTION FM-16-05

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve Resolution FM-16-05 allocating a lump sum amount of \$160,000,000 for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Minor Program?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve Resolution FM-16-05 allocating a lump sum amount of \$160,000,000 (\$84,072,250 for construction capital, \$10,000,000 for Complete Streets and \$65,927,750 for capital outlay support) for the FY 2017-18 SHOPP Minor Program.

BACKGROUND:

At its June 2016 meeting, the Commission passed Resolution G-05-16 delegating to the Department the sub-allocation and adjustment authority for minor capital construction projects. The resolution requires the Department to present its Minor Program to the Commission annually for review and approval. In addition, the resolution states that the following be included for projects to be allocated in the upcoming fiscal year;

- Project description, location, expenditure authorization (EA) number and performance measures.
- Program sum for day labor (material acquisitions only), right of way capital, construction capital and construction support.
- A lump sum amount for the construction capital and support costs and right of way capital of Minor B projects.

Consistent with Resolution G-05-16, the Department reviewed the Minor Program project list on the attachment with Commission staff. In addition, \$10,000,000 (construction capital only)

Complete Streets reservation for FY 2017-18 provides project funding for pedestrian, bicycle, and public transit elements.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolve that the amount of \$94,072,250 for construction be allocated from Budget Act of 2017, Budget Act Items 2660-302-0042, 2660-302-0890 and 2660-303-0042, and \$65,927,750 for capital outlay support, as a lump sum amount for the Minor Program for FY 2017-18, contingent upon the passage of the Budget Act of 2017.

Hi Susan,

I noticed that the 2017-18 Minor Construction Program Project List being presented by Caltrans to the CTC at next week's meeting includes the project called "Ruby 1" on Highway 197 in Del Norte County. I wanted to make sure that you and the Commissioners are aware that Ruby 1 is actually part of the larger "197/199 Safe STAA Access Project." Several of the other components of this project, which has been held up by litigation, were also originally scheduled to be SHOPP-funded, including "Ruby 2," which was supposed to be part of the minor program as well. However, none of these components appear in the latest (2016) SHOPP, nor do they appear in the Minor Construction Program Project List presented in the CTC meeting book.

I don't know the reason for Caltrans including Ruby 1 at this time, but Commissioners should be aware that this project cannot be constructed piecemeal, and funding it piecemeal seems similarly problematic.
