### Notice – 2016 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Guidelines Workshop

The California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopts guidelines for the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to describe the policy, standards, criteria and procedures for the development, adoption and management of the STIP. The guidelines are developed in cooperation with Caltrans, regional transportation planning agencies, county transportation commissions, and local agencies in accordance with Government Code 14530.1. Updated guidelines for the STIP are adopted biennially prior to the adoption of the fund estimate, which is adopted in August of every odd year.

To enhance transparency and accountability in programming the 2016 STIP, the Commission intends to update its guidelines by working with interested stakeholders. While this effort has centered mainly on recommended amendments to Sections 19, 31, 34, and Appendix B of the 2014 STIP guidelines, other sections may be identified for revision as the process moves forward.

The workshops are open to interested stakeholders. The first workshop was held on June 11, 2014 in Sacramento and the second was held on July 16, 2014 in Los Angeles. The third workshop will focus primarily on goals and performance measures for the 2016 STIP and is scheduled for:
