The California Transportation Commission (Commission) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) are co-hosting two kick-off workshops on the development of statewide comprehensive corridor planning guidelines and Caltrans corridor planning guidance.

The Commission is developing Comprehensive Corridor Planning Guidelines for use by Caltrans and regional transportation agencies intending to apply for the second round of funding for the Solutions for Congested Corridors Program (SCCP). The Commission guidelines are intended to establish basic expectations for plans associated with projects that are seeking funding through the SCCP.

Caltrans is preparing statewide guidance for the development of long-range, multi-modal corridor plans associated with the State Highway System. Caltrans guidance will provide direction to Caltrans districts developing corridor plans in collaboration with partners and will be relevant beyond the SCCP.
